

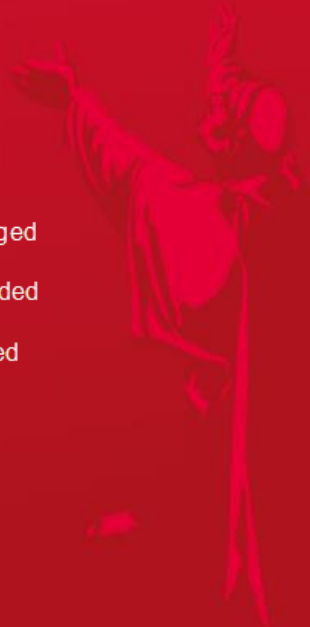


St. Stephen's Breakfast Club

Logistics of Provision

Breakfast Club is offered at St. Stephen's, for our pupils in Reception – Year 6.

Children can be dropped off for breakfast club at the main playground gate between 8am and 8.20am. The gate is closed at 8.20am.


Attendees at breakfast club will have the opportunity to enjoy breakfast at school (see menu below) and partake in activities and games. They will then be taken to their respective classrooms for the start of the school day.

We will use the emergency contacts, medical information and consent arrangements that we have on file for your child, if required, when caring for them at breakfast club. Please ensure that you inform school of any changes.
